Classroom Discipline Procedures

Level 1 Behaviours

Off task behaviour, not following teacher instructions, disruptive behaviours, speaking rudely, refusing to cooperate, running inside.

Level 2 Behaviours

Swearing, low-level violent activity, continued refusal to cooperate, absconding from the classroom.

Level 3 Behaviours

Physical violence, repetitive negative behaviours, cyber bullying, destruction to school property and other people's property.

Level 4 Behaviours

High level violence, possession of weapons and illegal substances.

Redirection

Teacher reminds student of school rules

First reminder

Teacher reminds student of school rule again and directs student to school poster.

Second reminder

Teacher reminds student of school rules again and possible consequences if behaviour continues. Another visual reminder given.

If this process is repeated twice in one day, treat as Level 2 behaviour

Police Notification

The Principal will notify the Police immediately

Thinking Time

Student is given 5-10 minutes thinking time in a designated classroom space or in a buddy classroom.

Executive Time Out

Student is removed from classroom to the Assistant Principal's room and remains there until the next break. Student completes a reflection sheet which is sent home with a letter to the parents (**Orange Card**) and recorded on Sentral. Student is off the playground for 2 days.

After 2 **Orange Cards** have been issued to a student, a **Red Card** is sent home

OR

Principal Notification

The Student is removed to the office and the Principal makes immediate contact with parents and a **Red Card** is completed.

In School Suspension

Student is removed from classroom environment to complete work in a designated space for up to 2 days. A resolution meeting with the parents, Principal and teacher occurs before student returns to class.

Out of School Suspension

Student is removed from school environment to complete work at home for 1 to 21 days. A resolution meeting with the parents, Principal and teacher occurs before student returns to class.
