Playground Discipline Procedures

Reviewed each school year

Level 1 Behaviours

No hat, littering, running in undercover areas, refusing to play by rules of game, name calling, teasing, climbing trees

Level 2 Behaviours

Out of bounds, low level violent activity (tackling, shoving, pushing), damaging school equipment, repeatedly not following teacher instructions

If this process is repeated

twice in

one day.

Level 3 Behaviours

Possession of weapon, threatening/swearing at staff, vandalism, leaving school grounds, throwing sticks or stones, high level violent activity (punching) In case of an emergency a red card is sent to the office

Level 4 Behaviours

High level violence, possession of weapons and illegal substances.

Police Notification

The Principal will notify

the Police immediately

Verbal Reminder

Teacher reminds student of school rule

Thinking Time

Student sits down for 5 minutes under the gazebo for some reflective thinking about their actions

Teacher Shadow

Student shadows teacher for 5 minutes to give them an opportunity to talk and discuss and reflect on the school rules

Time Out

Student is removed from the playground to sit in the 'No hat No Play' Zone for up to 30 minutes. Incident to be passed on to the classroom teacher who will record it on Sentral and will notify parents

Removal from Playground

If a student is in time out twice in a week, an **Orange Card** will be issued by the Assistant Principal. This will be recorded on Sentral by the Assistant Principal and parents will be notified. The student will be removed from the playground for 2 days and will complete a reflection sheet.

Principal Notification

Student is removed to the Office and the Principal makes immediate contact with parents and a **Red Card** is issued.

In School Suspension

Student is removed from classroom environment to complete work in a designated space for up to 2 days.

A resolution meeting with the parents, Principal and teacher occurs before student returns to class.

Out of School Suspension

Student is removed from school environment to complete work at home for 1 to 21 days. A resolution meeting with the parents, Principal and teacher occurs before student returns to class.
