Introducing our last learning disposition... Reflect!

Students have been introduced to this skill through a poster, character/icon and a series of short, focused activities in their classroom. Here is some of the language that has been used to introduce this disposition:

- K-2 I am a critical thinker, I set goals and I check how I'm going.
- 3-6 I am a critical thinker, I set goals and I evaluate my progress.



It would be wonderful if you were to use some of this language of learning at home. For example:

- Ask your child a few questions during or after activities, games, sports or projects, such as:
 - What worked well or what did you do well?
 - o What was difficult or challenging?
 - o What could you do differently next time or what could you change?
 - Did you learn anything new?
- Share your own reflections on small things in your life, what you have learnt and how you could change things next time

Reflect is our focus for Weeks 5-7.



Parking at Mowbray PS

PARKING around Mowbray is plentiful, but certain guidelines need to be followed to ensure pickups and drop-offs run smoothly for everyone – our kids are ALL important and ALL need our attention.

We have a school of over 620 children and we all need to be patient. Please TAKE A MOMENT to look through some reminders, for all families.

KISS AND RIDE zone on Mowbray Rd runs along the front of the school:

- Please move to the TOP of the zone to ensure the line moves smoothly and quickly
- Stop to drop off or pick up your child for a max of 2 minutes
 - Driver must remain in or within 3 metres of vehicle.
- Council Rangers patrol this area



Please take note of the **SCHOOL ZONES** around the school (40km/h limit - in operation between from 8am-9:30am THEN 2:30pm-4pm).

CUBBYHOUSE carpark is for the use of Cubbyhouse families and staff. They have kindly let Mowbray use the space as a drop-off area – but the system only works if everyone follows the rules and guidelines. Please:

- Note the directional signage and adhere to it (stick to the LEFT)
- Do not park in the Cubbyhouse turning circle, it is a "NO STOPPING" Zone



- Do not park in the 3x "NO PARKING" areas
- Do not park in the Cubbyhouse Staff Parking
- Do not park in the Disabled Parking unless you hold a Permit
- Do not stop and drop-off in the middle of the car park
- . If you plan to go into the Mowbray School grounds, you will need to park elsewhere.

Please do **NOT** park across any of our neighbours' driveways. Remember, everyone tries to park closely to the school - please park considerately, so spaces are maximised (eg don't leave excessively large gaps between cars)



There is a lot of **unrestricted parking** in Hart, Farran and Ulm Streets. Willandra Street and Mowbray Road parking is limited, but available. Please take note of the restricted parking in other areas. These areas may be patrolled.

Standard Traffic Signs and Rules

NO PARKING - You have no more than 2 minutes for dropoffs or pick-ups of passengers or goods. The driver must stay within 3 metres of their vehicle



NO STOPPING - You must NOT stop your vehicle at any point on the road or kerb, unless there is a medical or other emergency



DISABILITY - For the use of vehicles displaying valid permits only. No Stopping for others

Please help us maintain these guidelines to ensure everyone is safe!
