PRINCIPAL'S REPORT

Catching the Bus

The School Student Transport Scheme provides eligible school students with free or subsidised travel from home to school.

The criteria for a K-2 student is: A resident of NSW, or an overseas student eligible for free government education. Aged 4 years 6 months, or older. No minimum walking distance is required.

The criteria for a 3-6 student is: A resident of NSW, or an overseas student eligible for free government education. The straight line distance from their home to school address is more than 1.6km. The walking distance from home to school is 2.3km or further.

The school bus is for those students who are eligible for free travel. https://apps.transport.nsw.gov.au/ssts/schoolTravelPasses#/howToApply

Primary students who live too close to the school to be eligible may qualify for a School Term Bus Pass – information found at https://apps.transport.nsw.gov.au/ssts/schoolTravelPasses#/termBusPass

It has been noted by the bus company that there are students catching the bus who do not have an eligible pass leading to overcrowding. For the safety of all our students, please make sure that your child has a valid pass and please remind them to tap on and off the bus.

Reminder: Returning late or not returning in 2021?

Documentation of student movement is essential for the school executive to make 2021 classing structure decisions. Included in this newsletter is a form (that was also sent via School Stream) to inform the school if:

- your family will be taking extended leave over the December/January holidays and your child will be returning to school later than Friday 29 January 2021 (it is essential we have written documentation stating your proposed date of return) or
- your child in Kindergarten Year 5 will not be returning to MPS in 2021

Tell Them from Me (TTFM)

A big THANK YOU to our parent community, we had 154 responses to the Tell Them from Me survey. This is 109 more responses than 2019! This information will be used for the 2021 – 2024 planning cycle.

2021 Classing

At the end of every year, teachers and executive staff put <u>many</u> hours into forming classes for the next year. Teachers take into account how children work, who children work best with and friendship factors. As a school community we need to remember that children are in class for the best possible education, and classroom teachers have a deep understanding of class dynamics and how the students in their classes work best.

If you are concerned that your child has <u>significant special needs</u> that your 2020 classroom teacher is unaware of, or there are significant extenuating circumstances that need to be taken into account in 2021 classing, you can contact the office to make an appointment to meet with me or schedule a phone discussion. Appointments must be made <u>before</u> the 13 November. Alternatively you can send an email to the school to explain your child's significant special needs. Emails should be sent to <u>mowbray-p.school@det.nsw.edu.au</u> with the subject line 'Attention Principal re: 2021 classing'.

Any requests made will be considered, but are **not** guaranteed. Any request sent through after the 13 November 2020 will not be able to be considered.

If you would like to have your child considered for Year 7 selective high school entry in 2022, you need to apply online using a valid email address (not the student's email address). Detailed instructions on how to apply online are available at https://education.nsw.gov.au/public-schools-and-opportunity-classes/year-7.



Intention to apply for Year 7 placement in a selective high school in 2022

Dear Parent/Carer

Selective high schools cater for academically gifted students with high potential who may otherwise be without sufficient classmates at their own academic standard. Selective high schools help these students to learn by grouping them with students of similar ability, and by using specialised teaching methods.

Applications for selective high school placement are considered mainly on the basis of the Selective High School Placement Test results and school assessment scores. The Selective High School Placement Test will be held on Thursday 11 March 2021.

If you would like to have your child considered for Year 7 selective high school entry in 2022, you need to apply on the internet using a valid email address (not the student's email address).

Detailed instructions on how to apply online will be available in late September 2020 at https://education.nsw.gov.au/public-schools/selective-high-schools-and-opportunity-classes/year-7.

The application website opens at that link on 6 October 2020 and closes on 9 November 2020. You must apply before the closing date.

There are no paper application forms. If you do not have internet access, you could apply at a public library. If you have a disability that prevents you from using a computer, you can contact the Team for assistance after 6 October 2020.

You must submit only ONE application for each student.

School Travel for 2021



2021 school travel applications are now open

Applications for student travel in 2021 opened from Monday 12 October 2020.

Students who require a School Opal card or travel pass for 2021 can now <u>apply</u> online. A new application should be submitted if a student is applying for a school travel pass for the first time or requesting an additional pass as a result of a new shared parental responsibility situation (e.g. joint custody).

Students who have changed school/campus, changed address, repeated a year or received an expiry notification from Transport for NSW for their school travel entitlement should re-apply or update their details.

*Applications must be completed by the student's parent or legal guardian if the student is aged under 16 years. Students 16 years and over must complete the application form themselves.

Where there is a change of distance eligibility based on a student's grade, the system will automatically update a student's entitlement if they meet the new criteria. If they do not meet the new eligibility criteria, they will receive an expiry notification via email.

Students who have an entitlement approved under a medical condition which is due to expire will receive a notification advising them to re-apply.

Term Bus Pass holders will receive a notification to re-apply.

If a student needs to update their information or re-apply, they should go online to https://apps.transport.nsw.gov.au/ssts/updateDetails

Applications need to be submitted before **31 December 2020** to ensure that current student entitlements are updated and their current entitlement/card remains valid. If their application is submitted after 31 December 2020, the system will automatically cancel an entitlement/card and a new one will need to be issued.

Students in the Opal network applying for a SSTS or Term Bus Pass entitlement for the first time will receive their card at their nominated postal address. Cards will be mailed out from January 2021.

Students residing in Rural and Regional (R&R) areas should receive their travel pass at the commencement of the new school year from their nominated operator, this may be distributed via the school or sent direct to their address. Note: some R&R operators do not issue travel passes. Students/Parents should confirm with their nominated operator if they do not receive a pass.

New Concession Entitlement Cards

Transport for NSW will be replacing the below cards with Transport Concession Entitlement Cards (TCEC) from October 2020:

- Senior Secondary Student Concession Card (16 years and over) also used by Mature Secondary Students (18 years and over), Distance Education Students and Home School Students
- Proof of Age card (when a student under 16 years of age looks older)
- Boarder Rail Pass.

All previous cards will be valid until they expire. Students who require a Transport Concession Entitlement Card should speak with their school administration staff.
