Final reminder: 2024 Classing

At the end of every year, teachers and executive staff put <u>many</u> hours into forming classes for the next year. Teachers take into account educational needs, who children work best with and friendship factors. As a school community we need to remember that children are in class for the best possible education, and classroom teachers have a deep understanding of class dynamics and how the students in their classes work best.

Please remember job shares and composite classes are part of the school system, students will likely be in one of these structures during their primary schooling journey, possibly multiple times. At Mowbray we work hard to ensure all classing structures, and teaching teams are as successful as possible.

If you are concerned that your child has <u>significant special needs</u> that your 2023 classroom teacher is unaware of, or there are significant extenuating circumstances that need to be taken into account in 2024 classing, you can contact me via email or phone <u>by</u> Friday 17 November.

Emails should be sent to <u>mowbray-p.school@det.nsw.edu.au</u> with the subject line 'Attention Principal re: 2024 classing' explaining your child's significant needs or extenuating circumstances. All emails will be treated confidentially.

Any requests made will be considered, but are **not** guaranteed. Any request sent through after Friday 17 November 2023 will not be able to be considered.

Reminder: Returning late or not returning in 2024?

Documentation of student movement is essential for the school executive to make 2024 classing structure decisions. There is a form to fill in (located on School Stream in the 'School Information' Section) to inform the school if:

- your family will be taking extended leave over the December/January holidays and your child will be returning to school later than <u>Thursday 1 February 2024</u> (it is essential we have documentation stating your proposed date of return) or
- your child in Kindergarten Year 5 will not be returning to MPS in 2024
