#### **Thank You**

Thank you to all our parents/carers who have paid their Term 3 invoices.

School staff organise excursions/incursions that support the units of work they are teaching each term. Excursions and incursions are an opportunity to deepen student learning and provide an experience often unable to be done unless in a large group.

The reason that we can continue to provide these experiences is because of parent/carer support, so thank you for paying your term account promptly!

#### Holiday works

All Department of Education schools participate in the 'Share Our Space' initiative, which allows all school grounds to be used by the general public in the holidays.

These holidays COLA works will continue and there will be welding on-site each day.

These two projects pose a safety risk for anyone using the site, hence we will be closed for 'Share Our Space' this holiday period.

Although we are not participating in 'Share Our Space' I know that our community will possibly still come to use the grounds over the holidays. Due to construction and possible trucks entering and exiting the site, I politely advise that children are not allowed to be here unsupervised.

#### **Bushfire Information**

As we move into bushfire season (NSW 1 October to 31 March) we have been reviewing our school bushfire emergency plan. For this review we work with the Rural Fire Service and the DoE Work, Health and Safety team to devise the best emergency course of action if we have local bushfires. Included in this newsletter is a parent/carer factsheet that provides some general information.

If there is an emergency at school, our best source of immediate communication to parents is via School Stream. Please make sure your details are up to date.

I hope that all our students and their families have a fantastic holiday break! School resumes for all students on **Monday 9 October** for our final term of 2023.

#### **CAROLINE ALFORD - PRINCIPAL**

Stage 3 students from our school have recently undertaken an education tour of the national capital. Students were given the opportunity to participate in a variety of educational programs with a focus on Australia's history, culture, heritage and democracy.

The Australian Government recognises the importance of all young Australians being able to visit the national capital as part of their Civics and Citizenship education. To assist families in meeting the cost of the excursion the Australian Government is contributing funding of \$30 per student under the Parliament and Civics Education Rebate program towards those costs. The rebate is paid directly to the school upon completion of the excursion and has already been factored into costing that was charged to families.


